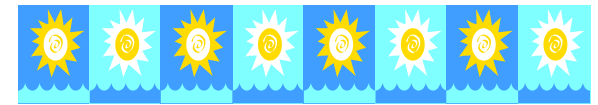
We know that learning is all around

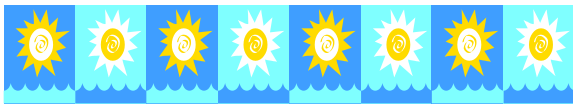

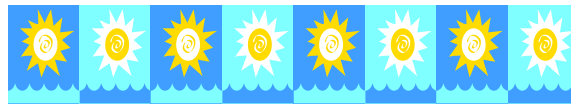
### Our Objectives

- Respecting belongings

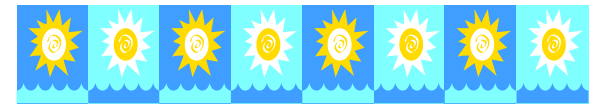
Our classrooms are set up with centers such as art, dramatic play, blocks, reading, science, math, and manipulatives.
